Story times help children build important early skills!

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A little something about our programs:

*Each meeting we will open with a song, and these same songs are repeated every week - repetition plays a huge part in early learning

*I plan each Story Hour/Toddler Time around a theme and I try to add a craft or activity that somehow relates to one of the stories or to the theme in general.



Preschool Story Hour- Tuesdays-11- 12 for ages 3 1/2 - 5

During Story Hour we will:

- * Read 1-3 books
- * Sing/ dance to 1-3 interactive songs
- * Participate in an activity with a felt board/props/puppets
- * At the end of the program we will make a craft or have a fun sensory activity

Story hour will help children build the skills they need to enter into school. Each week we will focus on letter recognition, comprehension, and engage in activities that will help build confidence, independence, social skills, & problem - solving skills.

Toddler Time- Thursdays-11- 11:30 for ages 18 months - 3

During Toddler time we will:

- * Read 1-2 short stories
- * Sing/dance to 1-4 songs
- * Recite 1-4 rhymes/finger plays
- * Participate in an activity with felt board/props/ puppets
- *Make a simple craft at the end or have a fun sensory activity

Toddler time focuses on movement, vocabulary building, identification, & fine motor skills



Baby Time- Wedensdays-11- 11:30 for Ages 6-18 Months

During Baby Time we will:

- * Read 1 short story
- * Sing 1-3 songs
- * Recite 1-4 rhymes/finger plays/movements
- *Participate in an activity with felt board/props/ puppets
- * Caregivers and babies will have a chance to socialize and play after the stories and activities.

Baby time focuses on movement & fine & gross motor skills and vocabulary building

Here are some things that will help our sessions run smoothly:



*Sit, sing, & listen to stories together. The more you participate in story time, the more children will participate, enjoy, and learn from story time.

*Please enjoy your food, toys, and devices after story time.

*It is okay for children to move around if they need to, as long as they aren't disruptive

*Don't be afraid to take a break. Some days children aren't in the right mood for story time. If a child is having a bad day or becomes disruptive, please feel free to step away from the group and try again when they are feeling better.

*Please try to be as timely as possible, but if you are late for story time, please be mindful when coming in when we are in the middle of a book.

*In case of bad weather, story times will be cancelled. I will contact you and post on our site and social media

*Each session will lasts for about 5-6ish weeks, please only register if you are able to make almost all of the meetings. We understand that things come up, but due to the limited number of seats, if you miss 3 weeks we may to give the spot to someone on the waiting list if the session is full.
