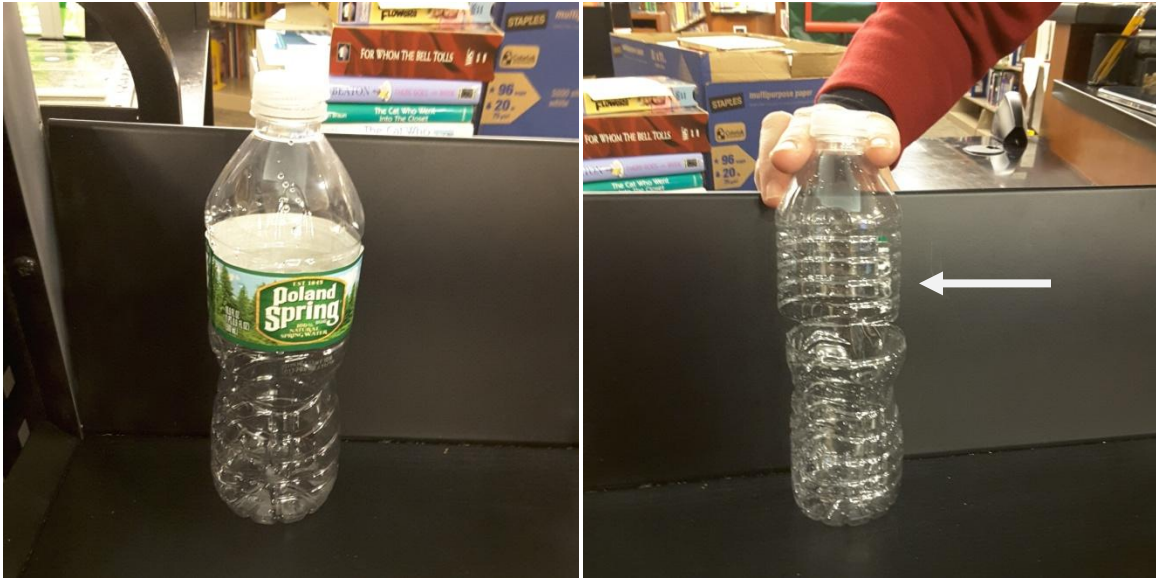


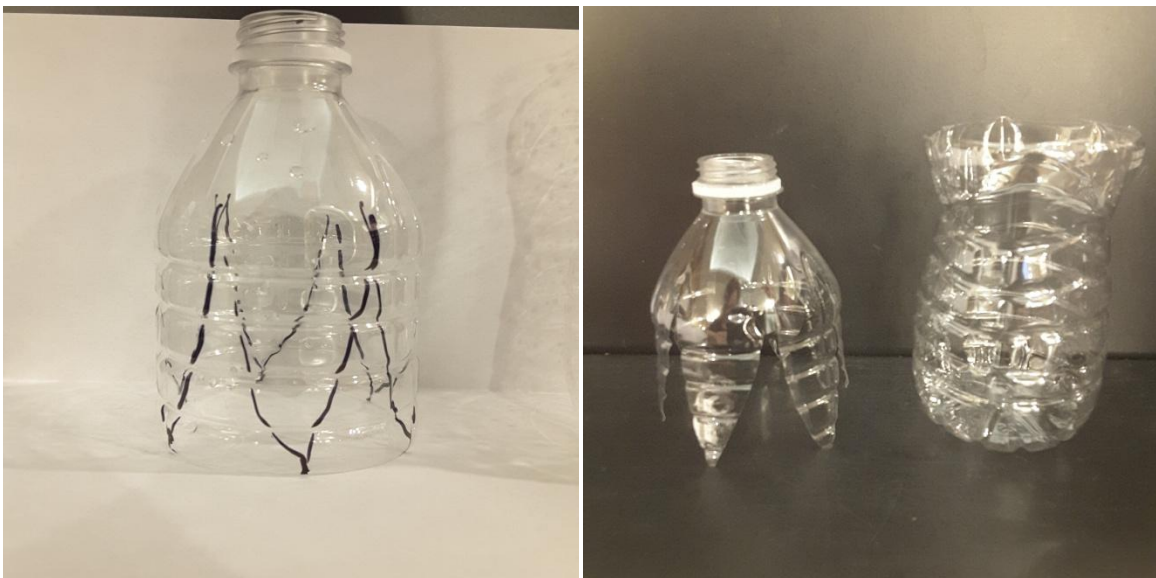
# “Upcycled” Rooting or Bulb Vase

You can turn an old water bottle into a vase to hold your plant cuttings and bulbs while they are waiting to be transplanted.

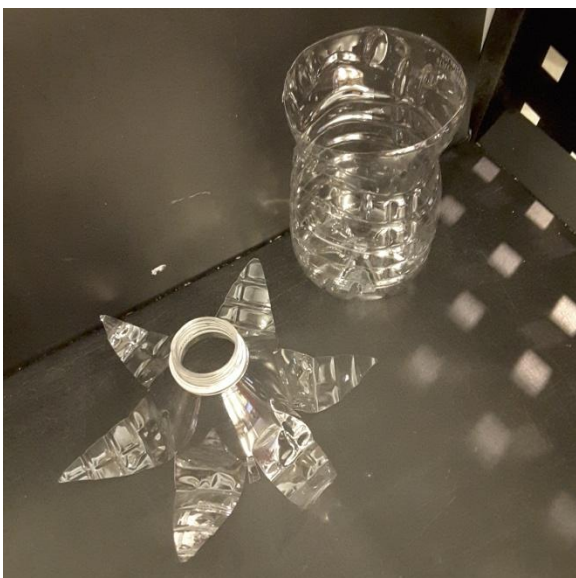
1. Remove label and cut bottle just above curve line (about an inch)



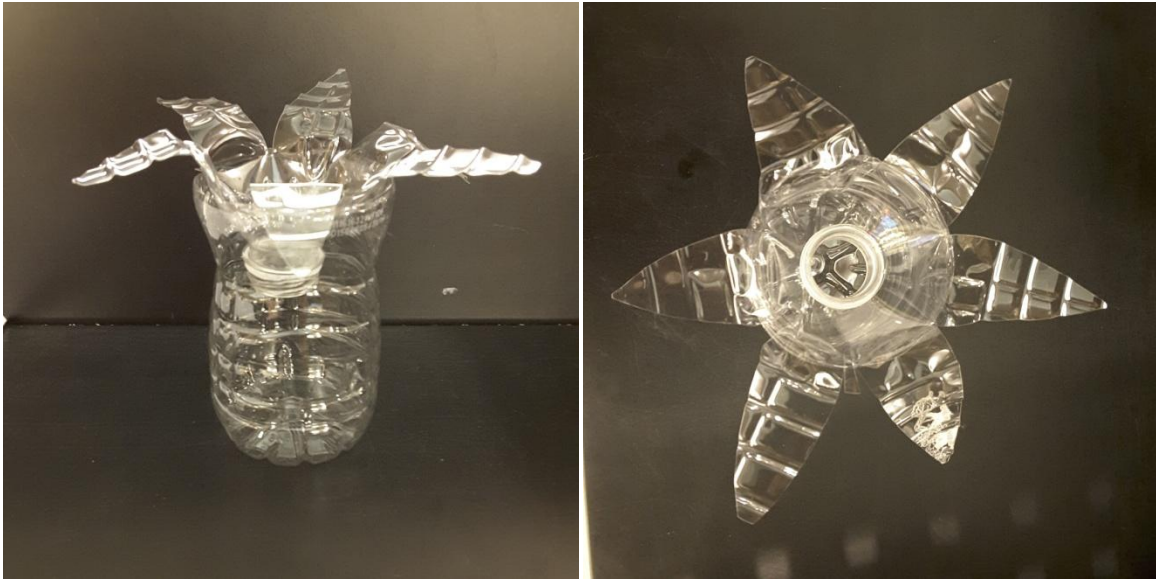
2. Mark six dots evenly around bottom ridge of top half, and cut V-shape slits starting at the dots. This turns the top of the bottle into a flower shape.



3. Press your thumb along the flower’s “petals” so they invert outward



4. Place in bottom that has filled with water – it should look sort of like a daffodil.



5. Add cutting or bulb into top lily so roots reach down into water
